Lexington Life Academy K-12 School for Autism

Our schools are currently **in-person** for those families that are looking for a traditional learning format.

We are also offering a variety of ways for students to continue their learning virtually, such as:

- ▶ Distance Learning
- ▶ Hybrid Learning
- ▶ In-home Learning

Distance learning includes either an online or print base, while **hybrid learning** allows for online check-in or live classrooms. Students then receive work that can either be printed at their home or dropped off weekly. **In-home learning** allows a paraprofessional to come into the home one to two times per week to work on daily classroom curriculum, daily living tasks, activities, social skills, and/or behavioral goals.

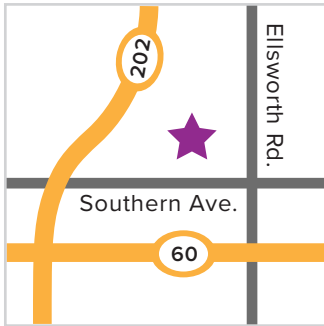
